Re: Language Amendment: New Brunswick Intermittent Agreement

Dear Chris:

After having the opportunity to discuss your request for an amendment to the NB Intermittent Agreement regarding the overtime meal entitlement for foreman at the Irving Oil Site in Saint John, New Brunswick, the National Maintenance Council for Canada has approved the following language addition to the Collective Agreement in Article 16.600 paragraph number 2:

When foremen are required to arrive at work up to one (1) hour prior to the normal starting time of the shift to organize work and obtain permits, they shall not be entitled to a meal or meal break as per Article 16.600 paragraph 1 unless they work more than two (2) hours beyond the end of their normal shift.

The addition of the new language provides a consistent approach for all maintenance contractors working on the Irving Site regarding meal entitlement provisions for foreman.

The Agreement posted on our website will be updated in the near future.
